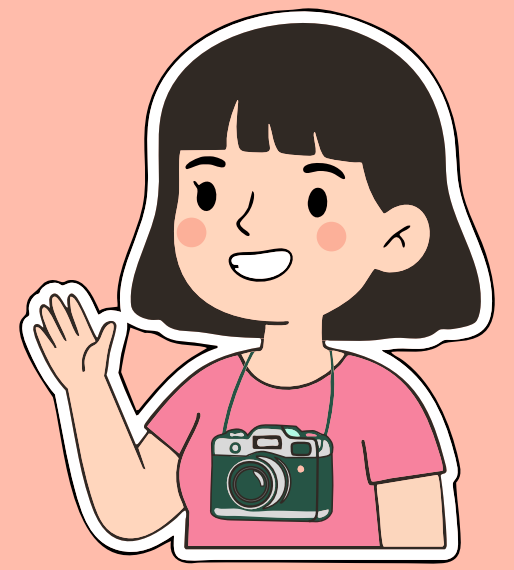

Essential Info at a Glance:

Currency:

We use the Argentine Peso (ARS). You can exchange money at casas de cambio or at the bank. Since April 2025, the dollar in Argentina only has one official value.

You can also pay with your credit card at the official dollar rate. If you opt to exchange at a casa de cambio, choose a trustworthy one like Western Union. For updated information, please check: bcra.gob.ar.



A few phrases:

- Hola (Hello) *OH-lah*
- Gracias (Thank you) *GRAH-syahs*
- Por favor (Please) *por fah-VOR*
- ¿Cuánto cuesta? (How much does it cost?) *KWAHN-toh KWEH-stah*
- ¡Salud! (Cheers!) *sah-LOOD*
- ¿Dónde queda esto? (Where is this?) *DON-deh KEH-dah ES-toh*
- ¿Puedes ayudarme? (Can you help me?) *PWEH-dehs ah-yoo-DAR-meh*
- Bondi (Slang for bus) *BON-dee*
- Birra (Slang for beer) *BEER-rah*
- Dale (Ok, hurry up) *DAH-leh*
- Canchero / Canchera (Slang for someone cool, o: for male, a: for female) *kahn-CHEH-roh / kahn-CHEH-rah*

Emergency:

Call 911 for emergencies.

Getting Around:

- **Subte:** The Subte (subway) is a great choice for a more local experience. It's quick, cheap, and gets you to most central spots. Pro-tip: Avoid rush hour if you can (it's intense). Grab a SUBE card to ride or tap on with your credit / debit card, also works using Apple Pay or any NFC method.
- **Buses:** They go everywhere and work 24/7. You'll have to check the map to navigate them and use a SUBE card or tap on with your credit / debit card, also works using Apple Pay or any NFC method.
- **Taxis:** Easy to hail, taxis operate using a taximeter; the starting fare during the day is around USD \$1.5, and at night around USD \$2. After that, each additional minute is approximately USD \$0.5. check your cash carefully to avoid inconveniences with the final fare.
- **Apps:** You can use apps like Cabify, Uber, or DiDi, it's safe and we use them everyday.

Connectivity & Phone Service

The best option for traveling these days is an eSIM. You can visit a store from Claro, Personal, or Movistar in the city to get one in person.

But if you're short on time, I recommend using [Airalo](#), my favorite eSIM service. For a \$3 USD discount, you can use my referral code: **GISSEL6471**

Safety Tips:

Pickpockets:

Keep your bag close, especially in crowded areas. You can get pickpocketed if you are unaware of your belongings, like in any other big city.

Scams:

- Watch out for the “mustard scam”: When someone “accidentally” spills something on you.
- Fake money when exchange at untrusted agencies.
- Taxis can also be tricky sometimes, as some drivers may try to charge far more than the actual fare or manipulate the taximeter so it runs faster than it should, be careful, as they may try to charge as much as possible. If you want to be 100% sure of what you’ll pay, it’s better to use Uber, DiDi, or Cabify instead.

Or be prepared to stand your ground and pay in cash. Of course, not all taxis are like this, but unfortunately, it can happen.



Night time:

Stick to well-lit areas. If you’re heading out late, maybe take a Cabify/Uber. If you are staying in Buenos Aires for over one month and want the full local experience, you can also ride the bus after going out. It is safe, but I only advise this if you are confident or with a group of local friends.

Where to Stay?

Choosing Your Vibe:

- **Palermo:** This is the place for trendy bars, cool shops, and street art. It’s where I’d stay if I wanted a fun, vibrant experience, but won’t if I wanted peace and quiet.
- **Recoleta:** Think elegant and sophisticated, with beautiful architecture and fancy cafes. It’s super chic and charming, also more residential.
- **San Telmo:** If you’re into history, antiques, and tango, this is your spot. It’s got a bohemian, old-school charm. It can get lonely during night hours.

- **Microcentro:** Super central and great for seeing the main sights, but it can be a bit hectic. It is also where all the government offices are, so you might run into a strike. Additionally, it gets lonely at night with homeless people around.
- **Puerto Madero:** Fancy and very nice neighborhood. If you are into a more luxurious holiday, this might be the neighborhood for you.

Must-See & Do:

Iconic Landmarks:

- **Teatro Colón:** This opera house is stunning. Try to catch a show or at least take a tour. Book tickets in advance at their [official website](#).
- **Recoleta Cemetery:** It sounds weird, but it's actually fascinating. Evita Perón is buried here, and it's full of history and beautiful architecture. Be sure to bring your ID and a card for payment.
- **Plaza de Mayo:** This is where Argentina's history happened. It's 100% worth a visit, especially with a tour guide.
- **La Boca:** Go on weekends to enjoy the flea market and absorb the vibrant energy, color, and passion of La Boca. The tourist area is only Caminito; you shouldn't go outside of that area.

You will read and hear comments about La Boca being dangerous. While it is not the safest neighborhood in BA, the tourist area is all right during the day, especially on weekends. Don't let these comments spoil your adventure.
